

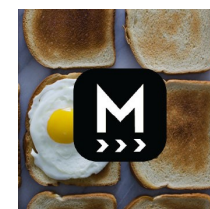


### Light Party - Tuesday 31st October
